GETTING STARTED

Acquiring GPS satellite signal

Always acquire the GPS satellite signal before using the navigator for navigation. To acquire the signal and to lock on your current position, please ensure that your car is not under a roof, tree or any object that might block the navigator from acquiring satellite signal.

Once you have launched the navigation software, the system will automatically search for satellite signal. To lock on to your current position, the navigator will need to lock on to at least 3 satellites. To acquire your altitude information, the fourth satellite is needed. The figure at the top right of the map screen indicates the number of satellite captured.

- ¹ When tapped, the estimated time of arrival will toggle between the estimated remaining time of arrival and estimated clock time of arrival.
- ² When tapped, the map screen will be zoomed in for more detailed view.

To toggle Auto Zoom

While navigating, you can choose to allow the navigator to decide the best level of zooming of the map. When activated, the map will be zoomed in when approaching junction and it will zoom out when travelling on a long straight road.



To enable or disable POI Label display

You may choose to enable or disable the display of label for POIs on map screen. If POI Label display is enabled, the name of the POI will be displayed on map screen.



Shortcut Buttons

There are several selected frequently used shortcut buttons placed on the map screen for easy access.

SEARCH DESTINATION

To change state

If you are travelling to a destination in different state, you will need to change the state in the navigator to your destination state before performing search function.





To search a road or P.O.I (Search AII)

From Where To, tap Direct Search.

Tap **Spell** to enter name of the desired destination.

Alternatively, you may search the desired result by browsing the list.

Tap the right arrow button to view the next page and left arrow to go to the previous page.

Enter the street name or POI using the keyboard.

TIPS

Enter the unique part of the street name and P.O.I for a fast and accurate search result.

For example:

JALAN PJS 7/19 to be entered as PJS 7/19 (the street name without JALAN, LORONG, PERSIARAN, etc) and JALAN SETIABAKTI 9 to be entered as **SETIABAKTI 9**. If you are searching for IKANO POWER CENTRE, just enter **IKANO**. You can search LOT 10 SHOPPING CENTRE by just entering LOT 10.

WHAT IS P.O.I?

P.O.I stands for Point Of Interest. Examples of P.O.Is are restaurant, shopping centre, petrol station, bank and etc.



After entering the name, tap **Spell** again to hide the keyboard.



The screen will display the results pertinent to the keywords entered.

Tap the desired destination from the search result. Tap **OK**.

Tap the right arrow button to view the next page and left arrow to go to the previous page.





Tap **Go** to set the location as destination and begin driving. You may save the location as Favorites for future retrieval. To learn how to save the location as **Favorites**, please turn to page 42.

TIPS

To search by P.O.I category (Category Search)



From Where To, tap Category Search.

Screen will display a list of P.O.I categories. You may select the desired category by tapping the icon.

Tap the right arrow button to view the next page and left arrow to go to the previous page.

All search result in relevant to the P.O.I category will appear. You may search the desired result by browsing the list.

Tap **OK** after selecting the desired destination. (Alternatively, tap **Spell** to enter name of the desired destination.)

Setting Way Points



Repeat step 1 to 8 in page 17 and 18 to search the stop you would like to make. Here, do not tap **Go**, instead tap **Save**.

(Before way points can be set, the destination need to be set first)

A pop up window will appear. Tap **Way Points**.

Way Point is set. The flag number represents the number of way points set.

To set multiple way points, please repeat step 10 and 11.

To perform simulation

To select Route Options

You can select your preferred route to use to reach your destination. There are 3 options to choose from; **Recommended Route**, **Min Distance** and **No Highway**.

Recommended Route	The navigator will consider all classes of roads and calculate the shortest time needed to construct the best route to your desired destination.
Min Distance	The navigator will consider all classes of roads and calculate the shortest distance by KM to construct the best route to your desired destination.
No Highway	The navigator will choose other classes of routes except highway to construct the best route to your desired destination.





Select and tap your desired route.

To view Route Info

Route Info displays the list of the roads that will be used in navigation; from starting point to destination. Please note that the **Route Info** can only be viewed after the destination has been set.


To view Route View

Route View displays the entire journey route on the map; from starting point to destination. Please note that the **Route View** can only be viewed after the destination has been set.



To Remove Route

You can cancel a destination set earlier by removing the route set. To remove a route, perform the following. Please note that the **Remove Route** button can only be tapped if the destination has been set.



To record the route taken (Record Track)

The navigator allows you to record the route taken of a journey on the map.



To view recorded route (Show Track)

In order to view the recorded route, the recording process needs to be stopped first (**Stop Recording**).



NOTES

If **Stop Recording** is displayed instead of **Record Track**, tap it to stop the recording process before tapping **Show Track**.





List of recorded route will be displayed. Tap the desired entry to view and tap **OK**.

Tap the right arrow button to view the next page and left arrow to go to the previous page.

Tap **View Map** to view the recorded track.

The recorded track is displayed.

NOTES

The recorded track shown on the screen is the actual travelling route. It is different from the suggested route generated by navigator when navigating.

SAVING DESTINATION

To save a destination to Favorites



After search is being performed, do not tap **Go**. Instead, tap **Save**.

A pop up window will appear. Tap **Favorites**.

Enter your preferred name to the destination using the keyboard. Once done, tap **OK**.

To delete History entry



From Where To, tap History.

The screen will display all recent searches.

Tap the right arrow button to view the next page and left arrow to go to the previous page.

Tap the destination you would like to delete. Then tap **Delete**.

To edit or delete a Favorites entry

From Where To, tap Favorites.

The screen will display all destination entries saved in the Favorites. You may search the desired result by browsing the list.

Tap the entry you want to edit from the search result. Tap **Edit**.

Tap the right arrow button to view the next page and left arrow to go to the previous page.

A pop up window will appear. Tap **Edit**.

To customize Speed Limit

You may set the speed limit in the navigator. When the speed limit is set, the navigator will alert whenever the car is drive above the preset speed limit. There are 2 types of road which you can set its speed limit; **Normal Road** and **Highway**.



NOTES

The speed limit ranges from 30km/h to 70km/h for normal road and 70km/h to 120km/h for highway.

To view GPS Signal strength



From **Settings**, tap **Theme Settings**.

Tap GPS Signal.

Screen will display the GPS signal page. The longitude, latitude, current time, height and vehicle speed will also be displayed.

To customize which P.O.I icon to be displayed on the map (POI Display)





Tap to check the P.O.I category icon that you want to appear on the screen and uncheck the P.O.I icon you do not want to appear on the screen.

TIPS

To display all P.O.I categories, check **All**. If you do not wish to see any P.O.I icon displayed on the map, check **Cancel All**.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Program stops responding when using it. Tap reset button at the back of the navigator and re-launch the navigation software.
- My search is returning too many results. Try performing a search by entering the most unique part of the keyword, for eg. IKANO for Ikano Power Centre.
- The location shown in the navigator does not reflect my true current location.

Check if the navigator is lock on to GPS satellite. You will need at least 3 satellites to be locked on. Fourth satellite is needed to identify your altitude.

 Voice guidance is not audible when navigating. Check the volume control of the navigator.

The navigation software cannot be launched.

- 1. Check the condition of the SD card. Change the SD card if it is damaged.
- 2. Check the SD card for viruses. If the SD card is infected by virus, format it and copy the software from the CD provided.
